Since 2002 she is the Deputy Head of the Institute of European Sport Development and Leisure Studies of the German Sport University. She is responsible for the research activities in European Sport Policy, Sport for Development, Social work and Sport.

Currently she is responsible for the impact evaluation of Programme “Sport for Development” of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development. Furthermore, she has a long-standing experience in European funded projects.

Karen gives lectures in the MA International Sport Development and Politics, the M Sc Sport Management and she is guest lecturer at the University of Rome/ Italy.

She published several books and articles in the field of Sport Policy and Sport Sociology, she is member of the „Editorial Board“ of the International Journal of Sport Policy and Politics (A peer reviewed, open access journal). Since 2002 she is board member (Vice President) of the European Network of Sport Education (ENSE).

“Good Governance in Sport Organisations (incl. Gender Policy)”

Good Governance in Sport Organisations is actually in Europe a very relevant topic, because many sports organisations need to revise their internal and external mechanisms to cope with the ongoing commercialization, professionalization and globalization of sport. The term “Good Governance” comprises a set of standards and operational practices leading to “effective regulations” of national sport federations as well as National Olympic Committees.

This webinar is guided by the need of assessing relevant aspects, such as transparency, democracy and social inclusivity. The presentation will emphasize on the importance of these principles of good governance with a special focus on gender policy. Herewith, the following five aspects will be discussed: National and international strategies on gender equality, Sport decision-making process, Gender equality in coaching, fight against gender-based violence as well as the role of the media in the fight against negative stereotypes.
